The **Animal Handling Glove** offers hand and arm coverage up to the elbow. Reinforced high-injury areas provide additional protection. The use of the gloves provide personal protection of the hand and forearm, decreasing the chance of bites and scratches, and transmission of zoonotic disease.

The **Procedure Glove** features the same protection as above but with first 3 fingertips exposed - allowing for palpation, vaccine administration, blood draws, ear cleaning, nail trims, and more.

Anyone and everyone in contact with animals: laboratory workers, groomers, kennel workers, research facilities, zoo and wildlife centers, pet owners can benefit from these gloves.

Laura Catena DVM, inventor of the ArmOR Hand® Protector Gloves, is a graduate of The Ohio State University School of Veterinary Medicine.
